Meeting Minuets: The meeting was called to order and new members and guest were introduced. In attendance were 28 members, 4 new members and 3 guest. The demo was given by Jon Reiver. Much old and new business was discussed. It was voted on not to buy a new lathe for the club at this time. Other discussions were sending a member to Campbell Folk School or bringing some out side turners to the club for demos. This was tabled until the Board members discussed the options. It was also voted on to send the \$200.00 the club received from the Southern States Symposium, to the Doug Barns memorial fund at John C. Campbell. Doug passed away in July of this year. He and his Wife were the directors of the Southern States Symposium in Gainesville, Ga. Our Club is a member of the Southern States wood turners. Doug was also an instructor at John C Campbell.



Monthly Demo: The demo this month was on Fluting and given by Jon Reiver. Jon talked about how to lay out your item using an indexing wheel which he made for his lathe. He discussed the various methods of routing or grinding the flutes in the side of his work. He suggested to do the fluting before hollowing out the inside of a vessel as the fluting may be deeper than you planned. This would cause you to cut through the sides of the vessel (unless you planned to do so). His hand out is attached to this





Safety Tip Of The Month: Utilize the tailstock whenever possible. This provides an added level of safety as it often times prevents the work from coming off the lathe during a mishap.



Always remove the tool rest before sanding and finishing. Failing to do so can result in serious injury to your hand and fingers.
