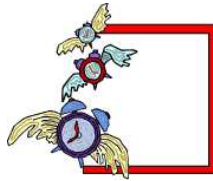

From Crossville: On 70-N , go seven (7) miles from K-Mart - Knollwood Trail is on the left. Go three tenths (.3) mile to 298 Knollwood Trail (red brick house). Don't confuse 70-N with 70-W.
