

### Les Black performed a DEMO on the Celtic Knot on a Rolling Pin


#### Celtic Knot Rolling Pin By Les Black

Les demonstrated the procedure for cutting, inlaying and turning a Celtic Knot on a Rolling Pin. He described a number of ways that this could be done and how to make a sled jig to assist in the cutting of the groves for the inlaying of accent colored wood. Les presented a number of Rolling Pins in different stages of the process to show how each step should look. He also turned a Rolling Pin that he had completely assembled to final thickness and finish. Good job Les.
