Meeting Minutes:

I. The meeting was called to order by the president at 6 PM.

II. Treasurers report. Charity Treasury: \$2285.41; Club Treasury: \$2932.09. A motion was passed to accept the Treasurer's Report.

III. Old Business:

A. The President thanked everyone who volunteered for the Apple Festival & Art Festival.

B. Ornaments: The President will write an Article for the newspaper. Bob Kohle reported that we had 409 Ornaments so far excluding those that were bought in today and 4 bags of memory ornaments. We need more.

C. Ted Pelfrey reported on Woodturning scholarships. We need to contact them for next year. Arrowmont is \$775 for a typical class and Room and Board is about \$500.

D. Members are encouraged to make more ornaments, Beads of Courage Boxes, Wig Stands and Memory Ornaments.

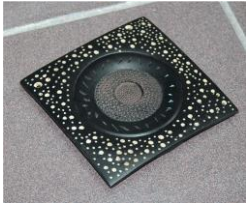
